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How to Fix the "Webpage Not Available" Error When Downloading WhatsApp Messenger

To fix this, you can clear your browser cache and delete all the temporary files that may interfere with your connection. Here are the steps to do this on Google Chrome:

1. Open Chrome and click on the three-dot icon at the top right corner.
2. Select More tools > Clear browsing data.
3. Choose a time range (e.g., All time) and check the boxes for Cookies and other site data and Cached images and files.
4. Click on Clear data and wait for the process to finish.
5. Restart your browser and try to access the webpage again.

Method 3: Change Your DNS Server Address or Proxy Settings

A DNS server is a system that translates domain names (such as [whatsapp-messenger.en.uptodown.com](^5^)) into IP addresses (such as 104.18.15.143) that your device can understand. A proxy server is a system that acts as an intermediary between your device and the internet, hiding your IP address or bypassing geo-restrictions.

Sometimes, these servers can cause problems when loading webpages, such as slow response time, incorrect configuration, or malicious interference. To fix this, you can change your DNS server address or proxy settings to a different one that works better for you. Here are the steps to do this on Windows 10:

1. Open Settings and click on Network & Internet.
2. Select Wi-Fi or Ethernet, depending on your connection type.
3. Click on Change adapter options and right-click on your network adapter.
4. Select Properties and double-click on Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4).
5. Choose Use the following DNS server addresses and enter the preferred and alternate DNS server addresses. For example, you can use Google's public DNS servers: 8.8.8.8 and 8.8.4.4.
6. Click OK and close the windows.
7. Restart your browser and try to access the webpage again.

If you are using a proxy server, you can disable it or change it to a different one by following these steps:

1. Open Settings and click on Network & Internet.
2. Select Proxy from the left menu.
3. Under Manual proxy setup, turn off Use a proxy server.
4. If you want to use a different proxy server, turn on Use a proxy server and enter the address and port of the new proxy server.
5. Click Save and close the windows.
6. Restart your browser and try to access the webpage again.

Method 4: Try a Different Browser or Device

If none of the above methods work, you may want to try a different browser or device to access the webpage. Sometimes, the error may be caused by a bug or an incompatibility issue with your current browser or device. For example, some websites may not work well with older versions of browsers or certain operating systems.
